<u>HB 2029</u>	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Establishes special education advisory council in chapter 302A, HRS, relating to education.	EDN, HLT, FIN
<u>HB 2435</u>	RELATING TO EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION. Requires the department of education to increase opportunities for special needs preschoolers to interact with their non-disabled peers. Appropriates funds.	EDN, HSH, FIN
<u>HB 2457</u>	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Allows the principal of each public school to establish and use a debit card system based at the individual school level for the purpose of purchasing school supplies and other related curriculum support supplies.	EDN, FIN
<u>HB 2494</u>	RELATING TO SCHOOL SPORTS CONCUSSIONS. Requires department of education to implement a concussion evaluation tool for each high school student athlete participating in the sport of football statewide. Appropriation.	EDN, HLT, FIN
<u>HB 2547</u>	RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS FOR MAUI PREPARATORY ACADEMY. Authorizes the issuance of special purpose revenue bonds for Maui Preparatory Academy.	EDN, FIN

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR ATHLETICS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

EDN, FIN

Appropriates funds for an athletic director at Anuenue School; equipment, supplies, and transportation for school athletic programs; and athletic programs for females.

HB 2792

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

EDN, LAB, FIN

Authorizes the board of education to provide wage adjustments to substitute teachers that are comparable to wage adjustments that are negotiated for teachers in collective bargaining unit 5.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW


