<u>HB 2811</u>	RELATING TO ENERGY. Transfers general funds into the energy systems development special fund. Appropriates funds from the energy systems development special fund for the Hawaii natural energy institute.	EEP, HED, FIN
<u>HB 2506</u>	RELATING TO REORGANIZATION OF STATE AGENCIES. Directs the Legislative Reference Bureau to conduct a study on Hawaii's most effective and efficient options to reorganize state agencies tasked with issues relating to energy and environmental protection.	EEP, LMG, FIN
<u>HB 2510</u>	RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT. Provides appropriation to auditor to contract with the UH for a study to modernize Hawaii's EIS process.	EEP, LMG, FIN
<u>HB 2550</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC UTILITIES. Increases the total rated generating capacity produced by eligible customer-generators. Increases the maximum capacity of an eligible customer-generator. Requires the public utilities commission to adopt rules that incorporate best practices interconnection standards.	EEP, CPC


