RELATING TO PUBLIC WORKS.  
Amends public works law to require 3-year suspension for any government contractor that delays an investigation or falsifies records.

HB 2272, HD1 RELATING TO QUALIFIED COMMUNITY REHABILITATION LAB, FIN  
(HSCR518-08) PROGRAMS.  
Status Exempts positions and personal services contracts with a qualified  
(Email Testimony) community rehabilitation program, which last for no more than one  
year, from county civil service law regardless of the cost. Effective  
07/01/2059.

HB 3163, HD1 RELATING TO THE SPECIAL FUND FOR DISABILITY LAB, EDB, FIN  
(HSCR470-08) BENEFITS.  
Status Amends the purpose of the special fund for disability benefits to allow  
(Email Testimony) for the use of currently available funds for automation purposes.  
Appropriates \$ from the special fund for disability benefits for  
automation of the department of labor and industrial relations'  
disability compensation division. Effective 07/01/2059.

HB 2481, HD1 RELATING TO HEALTH. LAB, FIN  
(HSCR519-08) Repeals the sunset date for voluntary employees' beneficiary  
Status association trusts pilot program established pursuant to Act 245,  
(Email Testimony) Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, as amended. Amends the voluntary  
employees' beneficiary association trust law to reflect permanent  
nature of the program. Effective 07/01/2059.


