RELATING TO GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS.

HED, LAB, JUD

Denies the University of Hawaii the use of the deliberative process privilege in closing an agency meeting to the public. Specifies that the deliberative process privilege does not cover meetings related to the budget of the University of Hawaii. Requires the University of Hawaii to disclose beforehand the range of proposed compensation to executives, including head athletic coaches. Extends annual salary reporting requirement to include salaries of head athletic coaches.



<u>HB 2584</u>	RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Directs the University of Hawaii to compile an inventory of all real estate holdings that the university controls. Establishes a priority list of lands available for development for university or non-university purposes.	HED, WLH, FIN
<u>HB 2585</u>	RELATING TO GRADUATE LOAN PROGRAMS. Establishes a graduate school loan program and corresponding special fund for qualified individuals in the areas of occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech language pathology, and school psychology. Provides for a loan forgiveness schedule for individuals who maintain approved employment. Appropriates funds for the program.	HED, HLT/HSB, FIN
<u>HB 2817</u>	RELATING TO MUSIC ENTERTAINMENT LEARNING EXPERIENCE PROGRAM. Makes an appropriation of \$4,800,000 for the music entertainment learning experience program at Honolulu community college, and issues general obligation bonds for site development, renovation, facilities remodeling, and studio construction.	HED, TAC, FIN
<u>HB 2444</u>	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Appropriates funds for an office of school redesign in the college of education at the University of Hawaii at Manoa.	HED/EDN, FIN
<u>HB 2020</u>	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT. Appropriates funds to support the statewide economic development program of the Hawaii Small Business Development Center Network hosted by the University of Hawaii at Hilo.	HED/EDB, FIN
<u>HB 2431</u>	RELATING TO THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Exempts board of regents of the University of Hawaii from Hawaii public procurement code requirements.	HED/EDB, FIN
<u>DECISION MAKING ON MEASURE PREVIOUSLY HEARD ON 1/22/08. NO TESTIMONIES ACCEPTED.</u>		
<u>HB 2134</u>	RELATING TO THE CENTER FOR NURSING. Makes permanent the deposit and disbursement of certain nursing fees into the compliance resolution fund for the credit of the center for nursing special fund.	HED, HLT, FIN




