<u>HB 2116</u>	RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII CENTER ON AGING EDUCATION AND RESEARCH. Appropriates funds to the University of Hawaii center on aging research and education faculty positions and program expenses.	HED, HLT/HSR, FIN
<u>HB 2133</u>	RELATING TO NURSING. Creates a nursing teacher loan forgiveness pilot program at the University of Hawaii.	HED, HLT, FIN
<u>HB 2134</u>	RELATING TO THE CENTER FOR NURSING. Makes permanent the deposit and disbursement of certain nursing fees into the compliance resolution fund for the credit of the center for nursing special fund.	HED, HLT, FIN
<u>HB 2163</u>	RELATING TO COMPTROLLER SUPERVISION OF ACCOUNTS. Limits the University of Hawaii duty to preaudit all proposed payments to those that amount to \$10,000 or more.	HED, FIN
<u>HB 2084</u>	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. Appropriates funds for 2 full-time executive-level positions at the University of Hawaii college of engineering.	HED, FIN


Submit testimony in one of the following ways:
