<u>SB 2831, SD1</u> <u>(HSCR1070-08)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII CENTER ON AGING EDUCATION AND RESEARCH. Appropriates funds to the University of Hawaii center on aging research and education for faculty positions and program expenses. (SD1)	HED, HLT/HSB, FIN
<u>SB 3075, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR2865)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO EPIDEMIOLOGIC INVESTIGATIONS. Grants the department of health authority to take samples necessary for epidemiologic investigations. (SD1)	HLT, JUD
<u>SB 3076</u> <u>(SSCR2668)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO EPIDEMIOLOGISTS. Authorizes the Department of Health (DOH) to create permanent or temporary exempt epidemiologist positions.	HLT, FIN
<u>SB 3077, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR2824)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO VOLUNTEER MEDICAL ASSISTANCE SERVICES. Provides immunity from liability and workers' compensation for licensed medical personnel providing volunteer medical services on behalf of the State or a county. Eff. 7/1/2050. (SD2)	HLT, JUD

RELATING TO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.
Allows the public to utilize the controlled substance pregabalin and makes Hawaii's controlled substance laws consistent with that of federal law. (SD2)

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW


Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
