Extends the sunset date of the increased conveyance tax allocation to the rental housing trust fund. Appropriates funds for expedited third party review of affordable projects. Establishes a self-help housing technical assistance trust fund. Increases the Hula Mae multifamily revenue bond authorization to \$500,000,000. (SB3174 SD2)

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING.  
Exempts new multi-family housing condominium developments of seventy-five units or more from certain state and county affordable housing requirements. (SD1)

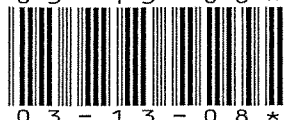

SB 2294, SD2  
(SSCR2816)  
Status

RELATING TO KAKAAKO.

WLH/HSB

Increases the reserved housing requirement for a planned development with a height of more than forty-five feet or a floor area that equals or exceeds 1.5 times the lot area for such development in the Kakaako community development district, mauka area for lots one acre or more in size. (SB2294 SD2)

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW



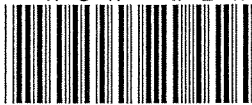

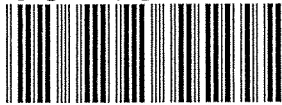
