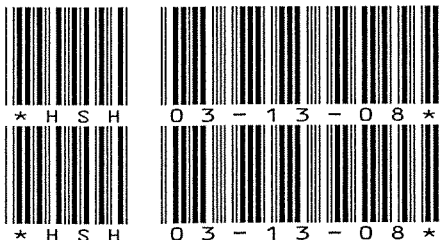

<u>SB 2226, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR2629)</u> <u>Status</u>	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE STATE COMMISSION ON FATHERHOOD. Appropriates funds for the state commission on fatherhood. (SD1)	HSH, FIN
<u>SB 3172</u> <u>(SSCR2683)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO RENTAL ASSISTANCE. Provides qualified rental assistance applicants up to six months to find a qualified rental dwelling.	HSH, FIN
