<u>HB 2321</u>	RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS. Establishes a peace mission committee within the office of international affairs to plan and implement peace missions to other nations and organizations. Appropriates funds.	INT, FIN
<u>HB 2032</u>	RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM. Prohibits the employees' retirement system from acquiring securities of companies that have active business operations with Uganda.	INT, LAB, FIN
<u>HB 2142</u>	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Directs the department of education to develop and implement, in consultation with other educational and community organizations, a student and faculty exchange program between Hawaii and its sister provinces in the Philippines. Appropriates funds.	INT, EDN, FIN
<u>HB 2624</u>	RELATING TO INTERNATIONAL LEARNING MISSIONS. Provides a tax credit for sponsorship of children that undertake international learning missions.	INT, EDB, FIN
