RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.
Prohibits the employees' retirement system from acquiring securities of
companies that have active business operations with Uganda.

RELATING TO EDUCATION.
Directs the department of education to develop and implement, in
consultation with other educational and community organizations, a
student and faculty exchange program between Hawaii and its sister
provinces in the Philippines. Appropriates funds.

RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS.
Establishes a peace mission committee within the office of
international affairs to plan and implement peace missions to other
nations and organizations. Appropriates funds.

RELATING TO INTERNATIONAL LEARNING MISSIONS.
Provides a tax credit for sponsorship of children that undertake
