SB 2546, SD 2 (SSCR 2758) RELATING TO OFFENDER REENTRY.

PSM, FIN

(SSCR 2758) Status Makes clarifying amendments to chapter 353H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, relating to the offender reentry program. Makes establishing

the program mandatory. (SB2546 SD2)

SB 2083 (SSCR 2770) Status RELATING TO THE SUPERVISION OF ADULT OFFENDERS.

PSM, FIN

Increases the membership of and appropriates funds for a full-time coordinator position for the state council for interstate adult offender supervision. Authorizes judiciary to assess a fee on parolees' and probationers' prison transfer applications for transfers out of the State. Establishes one full-time coordinator position under the judiciary.

(SB2083 SD2)
