SB 2900 Testimony Status	RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS. Establishes that there is no private right to possess any public roadway arising from the fact that the ownership of the roadway is disputed between the State and county in which the roadway exists. Gives counties the power to enforce traffic laws on these roadways without a presumption of ownership being created.	TIA/IGM, JDL
SB 1259 Testimony Status	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE. Requires proof of insurance to register a vehicle. Requires notice to the director of finance if the insurance is canceled. Requires surrender of license plates and certificate of registration upon cancellation of insurance. Requires suspension of the registered owner's driver's license if the license plates and certificate of registration are not surrendered after notice.	TIA/IGM, CPH
