| <u>HB 3415</u> | RELATING TO PUBLIC ROADS.
Allows any person to file for a contested case hearing to determine jurisdiction over a public road and establishes the determination process. | TRN/WLH, JUD,

| <u>HB 3406</u> | RELATING TO COMMERCIAL HARBORS MODERNIZATION.
Expands the authority of the Aloha Tower Development Corporation to assist in the development of the statewide harbors modernization plan by establishing the Harbors Modernization Group. Authorizes the Department of Transportation to issue revenue bonds to finance the harbor improvements. | TRN/WLH, FIN |
| <u>HB 2893</u> | RELATING TO INTRA-COUNTY FERRY SERVICE.
Requires department of land and natural resources to assign priority mooring space to intra-county ferries serving a county with 500,000 or less people and at least 3 islands inhabited by permanent residents. Exempts distributors from fuel tax for fuel sold for ultimate use by the intra-county ferry service. | TRN/WLH, FIN |



DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

- The date and time of the hearing;
- Measure number; and
- The number of copies the Committee is requesting.

While every effort will be made to copy, organize, and collate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed to the incorrect office, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.

PAPER: 10 copies (including an original) to Room 441 in the State Capitol; or




Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
