passengers. Restricts use of fees to areas directly affected by tourism.

Requires prior legislative approval before county may impose fees.

RELATING TO COUNTY FEES.

TRN, TAC, FIN

Allows a county to impose a service fee on a cruise ship owner if the county provides direct services to a cruise ship passenger while the

passenger is in the county.
