DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least 24 hours prior to the hearing with a transmittal cover indicating:

- Testifier's name with position/title and organization;
- The Committee the comments are directed to;
- The date and time of the hearing;
- Measure number; and
- Note if you are planning to testify in person OR if you are not planning to testify in person and want the comments inserted into the official record only.

While every effort will be made to copy, organize, and collate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed to the incorrect office, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.

Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:

PAPER: 1 original to Room 420 in the State Capitol; or


For those who do NOT plan to testify in-person (insertion of written comments into official record only):

Go to conveniently located special House Information Desks at the Auditorium's entrance the day of the hearing for assistance or additional information.


Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.


