[Testimony](#) Appropriates matching funds from the department of land and natural resources for Kauai county's acquisition of a public right of way to Haena beach park.

[SB 3223](#) RELATING TO REAL PROPERTY. WTL/IGM, WAM
[Testimony](#) Appropriates funds to be matched by the city and county of Honolulu for the creation of a GPS/GIS based property ownership data base for Oahu.

[SB 3206](#) RELATING TO KAWAI NUI MARSH. WTL, WAM
[Testimony](#) Establishes the Kawai Nui marsh advisory council; appropriates moneys to DLNR for the work of the council.
