EDU/HSP <u>SB 2878</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO EARLY LEARNING. Creates the Early Learning Council to govern the state's early learning system. Establishes an early learning system. Establishes the Keiki First Steps Program.	EDU/HSP, WAM
EDU ONLY <u>SB 2820</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds to fund department of education and the University of Hawaii repair and maintenance projects.	EDU, WAM
<u>SB 2881</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Creates the facilities alignment commission to revitalize school facilities by developing and submitting recommendations for areas for new school construction, schools for expansion, and schools for consolidation or closure. Allows the legislature to disapprove these recommendations only in their entirety. If no legislative disapproval occurs, requires the Board of Education to comply with these recommendations.	EDU, WAM
