<a href="#">SB 2011</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Requires a delegation of procurement authority in writing and filed with the administrator of the state procurement office. Makes designee answerable to administrator where the designee is in a position subordinate to the chief procurement officer. Applicable to procurement over certain dollar amount.	TSG, WAM
<a href="#">SB 2409</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a>	RELATING TO PUBLIC PROCUREMENT. Establishes procedures and criteria and appropriates funds to prevent state or county purchases from businesses that operate sweatshops.	TSG, WAM
<a href="#">SB 2574</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Requires that moneys received pursuant to a solicitation of funds by a government body to cover costs and expenses of state-sponsored trips and endeavors to generate business opportunities and goodwill be deposited into the general fund and disbursed pursuant to legislative appropriation. Appropriates funds.	TSG, WAM
<a href="#">SB 2221</a> <a href="#">Testimony</a>	RELATING TO PUBLIC RESTROOMS. Provides funding to ensure that public restrooms are consistently well maintained. Appropriation.	TSG, WAM
