RELATING TO TAXATION.

WTL, EDT, WAM

Testimony

Provides an enhanced tax credit for owners who donate their hazard-

prone property to a public entity, or private non-profit land trust, for a permanent non-developmental purpose that is related to a public use.

SB 2528 Testimony RELATING TO STATE PARKS ON KAUAI.

WTL, WAM

Establishes a sub-account under the state parks special fund into which 100% of the proceeds collected from the various fees collected at the Kokee state park and Waimea canyon state park, less any net amounts due to OHA, will be deposited and used to cover the cost of repair, maintenance, and operation at the Kokee state park and Waimea

canyon state park.

SB 2747 Testimony RELATING TO HUNTING.

WTL/ENE, JDL

Provides the board and the department of land and natural resources with the power to make rule changes and decisions regarding hunting

without going through the rulemaking process.
