The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) supports GM 427 to appoint Elton S. Ushio to the Kauai Aquatic Life and Wildlife Advisory Committee for a full term to expire on 06-30-2012.

The Kauai Aquatic Life and Wildlife Advisory Committee is composed of five members appointed by the governor in accordance with Section 26-34, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and who are knowledgeable in hunting and fishing.
