The Hawaii Public Housing Authority (HPHA) <u>supports</u> this measure to increase public safety at public housing projects.

Well-defined and supporting laws are required to assist the HPHA and police officers in warning and requesting persons who remain unlawfully on public housing project property to leave. This measure will help to curb activities, such as loitering, vandalism, and drinking alcohol, by non-residents and uninvited guests on public housing properties. The bill will provide an additional mechanism for HPHA managers and Honolulu Police officers to provide public housing residents with a safe living environment.
