development as well as workforce development in Hawaii by
appropriating funds to the College of Engineering at the

Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- (1) Changing the appropriation amount to \$1 to promote
further discussion; and

consistency, and style.


As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
