TESTIMONY ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2165, RELATING TO NURSING.

TO THE HONORABLE JERRY L. CHANG, CHAIR, TO THE HONORABLE JOSH GREEN, M.D., CHAIR, AND MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEES:

My name is Kathy Yokouchi and I am the Executive Officer of the Board of Nursing ("Board"). I thank you for the opportunity to present testimony in support of House Bill No. 2165.

This bill allows a graduate with a completed portion of a Board of Nursing approved master's entry nursing program to apply for a license as a registered nurse by examination.

The Board is in support of House Bill No. 2165 because:

• The master's entry nursing program will not replace the generic baccalaureate nursing program, but instead provide an additional pathway to prepare registered nurses for licensure. By providing this second pathway to nursing, this program may help to alleviate the nursing shortage because it may increase access to the University of Hawai'i at Manoa's generic baccalaureate program since beginning level college

- students would not be competing with experienced, college-prepared students for the spaces in this program.
- The Board is aware that there are more than 50 similar accelerated or fast track programs with entry at the Master's level, across the country. The American Association of Colleges of Nursing has indicated that this type of program has been successful in preparing competent nurses.

For these reasons, the Board respectfully requests your Committees' approval and passage of this measure.

House Bill 2165- Relating to Nursing
