The Hawaii Public Housing Authority (HPHA) supports the intent of this bill to provide additional security at Mayor Wright Homes to the extent that it does not adversely impact priorities as indicated in the Executive Supplemental Budget.

Please note that HPHA currently receives \$1,500,000 for private security guard contracts for its family and elderly housing projects statewide. Under this level of funding, HPHA is only able to provide one 24-hour gate guard and two 6-hour roving shifts of two guards, at a cost of approximately \$333,074. This bill appropriates \$235,582 for the contract hiring of at least three security officers at Mayor Wright Homes. HPHA needs an additional \$1,500,000 to create an effective security force at family public housing projects across the state.

HPHA is ready to utilize any additional funding provided to improve the security of its public housing residents. HPHA is currently looking into changes to its security configuration such as the hiring of off-duty police officers and off-duty sheriffs to complement the contracted security guards. HPHA believes that security officers with arresting powers are needed to effectively address security problems at the public housing projects. Therefore, HPHA requests that additional fund be approved, but that the funds are not restricted to hiring security guards.

In regards to section 2 of the bill, requiring HPHA to submit a report to the Legislature on the security situation at Mayor Wright Homes, HPHA is currently open to discussions and sharing of information with the Legislature, public housing residents, media, and the community on how HPHA can improve security at Mayor Wright Homes. HPHA is trying to cultivate an ongoing, open dialogue on all aspects of its management of public housing projects statewide.
