LATE TESTIMONY

H.B. 2848 – RELATING TO GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES

The Hawaii Government Employees Association, AFSCME Local 152, AFL-CIO supports the purpose and intent of this measure. H.B. 2848 proposes rehiring state and county retirees into critical-to-fill or labor shortage positions without adversely affecting their retirement benefits. In addition, to qualify for full-time employment, the retiree must be retired at least one year prior to reemployment. Changing demographics and low unemployment rates makes rehiring experienced and well-qualified retirees for critical-to-fill positions an important consideration.

However, we believe the future of civil service depends upon active recruitment of those applicants with the skills, abilities and commitment to a government career. This includes current employees who should be considered for promotional opportunities under the civil service merit system. Widespread reliance upon retirees will not encourage the recruitment and promotion of these career employees or address the challenges of succession planning.
