RELATING TO HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE

Chair Magaoay and members of the Committee, thank you for the opportunity to testify on H.B. 3428, H.D. 1.

The Department of Accounting and General Services (DAGS) supports H.B. 3428, H.D. 1's requirement that all signs in the State Capitol be in both English and Hawaiian.

DAGS believes that the bill could make the task more effective by designating the State board on geographic names as the authority for the English and Hawaiian translations and spelling.

DAGS also notes that it is not practical to have an English translation of the motto or the Hawaii State Seal or replica's of it and that if the Hawaiian words on them need to be properly spelled and punctuated, it may require that the original artwork be modified.
