Requesting the Hawai'i Tourism Authority to Negotiate a Contract Extension with the National Football League to Keep the Pro Bowl in Honolulu

The Hawai'i Tourism Authority (HTA) strongly opposes H.C.R. 213 and H.R. 181, which requests the Hawai'i Tourism Authority to negotiate with the National Football League (NFL) the extension of the contract to hold the annual Pro Bowl in Hawai'i.

Negotiation is the process of submission and consideration of offers until an acceptable offer is made and accepted. The HTA is engaged in on-going negotiations with the NFL on the Pro Bowl. The adoption of resolutions such as these will weaken the HTA's negotiating position.

Further, the figures in the fourth WHEREAS should be corrected. The Pro Bowl does not bring "hundreds of millions of dollars" in revenue each year. The 2008 Pro Bowl, in February, brought in 24,761 visitors, who accounted for \$28 million in spending and generated \$2.5 million in state taxes.

Because the HTA is already in negotiation with the NFL on the Pro Bowl, these resolutions are not necessary, and we request that they be held.
