RENAMING THE NATURAL ENERGY LABORATORY OF HAWAII AUTHORITY AS THE GEORGE R. ARIYOSHI

Chairs Yamashita and Tsuji, Vice-Chairs Wakai and Brower, and Members of the Committees:

The Hawaii Aquaculture Association (HAA) supports the intent of HCR 303/HR253 to rename the Natural Energy Laboratory of Hawaii Authority to honor former Governor George R. Ariyoshi who was instrumental in the development of this facility as well as supporting the development of the Hawaii aquaculture industry. However, since energy research and development is only a portion of past and present activities at this facility, and since aquaculture research, development, and commercialization has long been the primary activity at the facility, both past and present, The HAA believes a more inclusive name would be more appropriate for this multi-purpose State facility, to include aquaculture.
