Chair Evans, Chair Ito and Committee Members:

I am Major General Bob Lee, Director of Civil Defense, State Department of Defense. I am providing written testimony in support of House Concurrent Resolution 72.

This resolution provides for the designation of a state agency to develop a statewide land use strategy to mitigate potential damage to public infrastructure and private property due to disasters. From a State Civil Defense perspective, we welcome the opportunity to develop such a strategy as it will improve hazard mitigation planning at the State and county levels.

We defer to the DBEDT Office of Planning for specific evaluation criteria. However, we are willing to participate in consultation with other state agencies and stakeholders to develop the land use strategy.
