Strategies for Depleted Uranium on Army Posts in Hawaii

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Background

- In August 2005 at Schofield Barracks,
 the Army discovered depleted uranium (DU):
 Parts of spotter rounds for the Davy Crockett weapon.
- In August 2007 at Pohakuloa Training Area (PTA), Army contractor, Cabrera Services, saw evidence of Davy Crockett use.

Legal Constraints

- DU is under the sole authority of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC).
- DOH lacks authority on federal property for radioactive materials.
- DOH can monitor off-base
- In early 2007, the Army invited DOH to help resolve the DU issue on Army posts in Hawaii.

DOH Objectives

- Ensure that DU does not harm the general public.
- Affirm that the Army is the responsible party.

- Check the Army's health risk assessment and public health protections.
 - DOH reviews data, protocols, analyses, & results.
 - So far, the Army has made all records available.
 - Army surveys have met nationally-accepted protocols and standards.
 - DOH uses a third party radiation expert.
 - David Allard, Certified Health Physicist, has much experience in health physics, DU production & clean-up

- Address concerns of the general public that DU from the Army hurts public health.
- DOH measures ambient radiation periodically:
 - In W. Hawaii downwind from Pohakuloa TA, and
 - On Oahu from Kapolei to Waianae.


Radiation Levels

- Since May 2007, average ambient levels have been ≤0.005 milliroentgens per hour (mR/hr).
- Action level for general public protection is
 2.000 mR/hr (2000 μR/hr) (400x greater) to
 meet limit of 2 mrems in any one hour.
 - Action level set by National Council on Radiation Protection & Measurements (NCRP), NRC, and State Rules (HAR, ch 11-45).



- Independent testing of DU from Army posts.
- Conduct analysis on split samples.
 - Discussing test methods
- Monitor air with EPA equipment & analyze samples at Pennsylvania's accredited radiochemistry lab.
 - DOH has no accredited radiochemistry laboratory.

- Provide facts on DU to the general public.
 - Answer telephone, e-mail, and mail questions.
 - Explain use of monitoring equipment
 - July 28, 2007, Hilo
 - August 11, 2007, Kona

- Provide facts on DU to the general public (cont).
 - Conduct DU update community meetings.
 - Oct. 12, 2007, Air & National Guardsmen in Hilo
 - Nov. 16, 2007, w/ Rep. C. Evans & Army in Waikoloa
 - Nov. 17, 2007, Puako & Kealakahe, and
 - Nov. 18, 2007, Waimea Senior Center.
 - More meetings later.

Expectations

- Complete baseline human health risk assessment in early 2008.
- Determine actions to be taken for PTA.
- Assure public health.
- Continuous talks with military.
