

LATE TESTIMONY

The House Committee on Judiciary March 28, 2008 2:00 p.m.

S.B. 2263, S.D.2 Relating to the University of Hawaii

The University of Hawaii Professional Assembly (UHPA) has advocated for the disclosure of the salaries proposed for excluded administrators at the University of Hawaii prior to formal action by the Board of Regents. This is the second legislative session where UHPA has sought to obtain the necessary statutory changes. During this legislative session, the UH administration and UHPA have discussed this matter and exchanged appropriate views.

S.B 2263, S.D. 2 contains language that UHPA can support on seeking salary disclosure. The amendments are found in Section 2 and Section 3 (a) (2). In regard to the proposed administrative salaries UHPA would request language that requires a six business day notice previous to an open meeting convened for the purpose of public comment.
