## Testimony of Chiyome Leinaala Fukino, M.D. Director of Health

February 4, 2008, 1:15 p.m.

- **Department's Position:** The Department appreciates the intent of this measure provided it does not adversely impact our Executive Supplemental Budget. 2 Fiscal Implications: Appropriates an unspecified amount of funds for purchase in fiscal year 2008-2009 of five automated external defibrillators to be located on each floor of the State Capitol building. Purpose and Justification: The Department appreciates the Legislature's interest in public safety and 5 its desire to make available automated external defibrillators (AEDs) on each floor of the State Capitol. 6 There is no question that early defibrillation saves lives, and that public access to AEDs along with good 7 training and practice can deliver early defibrillation to cardiac arrest victims. The promulgation of 8 AEDs in more public spaces has been greatly assisted by the passage last year of SB 1675 which 9 10 expands the immunity for good faith use of an AED and implementation of programs for its use.
  - Agencies and businesses who want to implement programs, and physicians and other health professionals who assist are afforded protection that would allow the implementation of a program at the State Capitol without the assistance of the Department of Health.
