Co-Chair's Tsuji and Ito, and Members of the Joint Committees:

Thank you for the opportunity to testify on S.B. 2643 relating to Irrigation. The purpose of this bill is to authorize general obligation bond funds for the repair and maintenance of certain irrigation systems, and for additional personnel to improve irrigation system management.

The Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL) supports the intent of this bill provided it does not conflict with the Administration's priorities as reflected in the Executive Supplemental Budget.
