TESTIMONY OF THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE BOARD OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES

On Senate Bill 2749 -- RELATING TO THE NI'IHAU ISLAND RESERVE COMMISSION

Before the SENATE COMMITTEES ON AGRICULTURE AND HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS and WATER AND LAND

February 12, 2008

Senate Bill 2749 proposes to create a Ni'ihau Island Reserve Commission with broad powers of governance in regard to cultural and natural resource issues. The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) opposes this measure, which circumvents both state and county authorities and conveys them to a small group of individuals who are not democratically elected.

The Department calls to attention that SECTION 4 of this measure which preempts the enforcement powers of the Department's Division of Conservation and Resources Enforcement in state waters surrounding Ni'ihau, SECTION 6 preempts the authorities of the County of Kauai, and SECTION 7 preempts the authorities of the Department's Division of Aquatic Resources to regulate public fisheries.

In closing, the Department believes that this bill as drafted would impede the State from fulfilling its public trust obligations as laid out in Article 11, Section 1 of the State Constitution.
