Dear Representative Waters and Committee Members:

The Collection Law Section of the Hawaii State Bar Association requests that you give consideration to submitting legislation to increase the District Court Civil Jurisdictional Limits to \$30,000.<sup>1</sup> Currently, the limit is \$20,000 and has been that way since the early 1990's. Increasing the limit would take into account inflation over the years and would allow cases in the \$20,001 to \$30,000 range to be litigated and resolved in a forum that is more cost effective relative to their size. Keeping the cost of disputes down is beneficial to both individuals and businesses.
