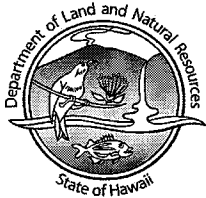

LATE TESTIMONY

Senate Bill 2926 proposes to make the operation of motor vehicles on unencumbered lands, other than on roads, trails, or tracks designated or provided by the Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) for vehicular use, a petty misdemeanor and imposes mandatory fines. The Department supports the intent of the bill and offers the following comments.

While the Department supports any measure that facilitates or enhances the enforcement of its statutes and rules, we believe that it is a better and more efficient practice to address any perceived deficiencies in enforcement capabilities in a global manner rather than a case-by-case, subject matter driven approach.

The Department notes that its Administration bill, Senate Bill 3100 and its companion measure House Bill 3178, would provide greater fines for the violations addressed by the bill. The Department believes that the Administration bill is a preferable vehicle for addressing the enforcement matters that are the subject of this bill since it not only addresses those specific violations but also increases the Department's overall effectiveness for enforcing all violations on unencumbered lands.

To the hearing committee:

This is wrong and unnecessary. The state has not provided enough places to which recreational vehicle enthusiasts have access to. Kahuku motocross track is one place and only caters to one group. And the Sandbox project at Sand Island has been stalled. There is also no race track on O'ahu and now you plan to impose further insult by making this law. You give us nowhere to go and then tell us it's illegal to go anywhere that you don't designate. Open places for us first! You are also closing off the hunting trails, how are we supposed to access the hunting areas, some don't have marked trails, and are only accessible practically by vehicle. To take on part of the bill per say:

"The use and operation of these vehicles has the potential to desecrate sacred burial grounds, further threaten already endangered species, and harm the natural ecosystem on public lands. However, many people have expressed concerns about the ongoing use of off-road vehicles in Hawaii's most sensitive areas."

Construction does more damage to burial grounds than anything else. And if the state would take better action against this it would be better for all involved considering the recent problems with burials and construction sites. What natural eco-system on public lands, no all unencumbered lands are in their natural eco-system, some of us use the access to clear invasive species, and illegal marijuana growers patches (reporting them to police). As far an endangered species this is more a problem of education, use of the tread lightly principals, and

awareness of where certain species are is more paramount than just telling someone they can't go there.

I am very culturally sensitive and care about what happens here in Hawaii. I am born and raised here in the islands. I am from Maui, currently living on O'ahu. I am a Hawaiian activist, and have my B.A from UH Manoa in Hawaiian Language, and I am a Masters Candidate in Hawaiian Studies now. I am not ignorant when it comes to Hawaiian plants, protocol, or practices. Some areas used for gathering rights is only accessible by 4wheel drives.

Also in light of the supreme court's ruling on the OHA vs. the State of Hawaii, you have no right to sell or transfer ceded lands. By right that would also mean that you can not remove any Hawaiian (Kanaka Maoli) or Hawaiian Citizen (Kingdom Subject or National) from any ceded lands. So if I happen to be somewhere that is state land it would first have to be proven that it is NOT ceded land for your to have proper jurisdiction. As of right now there is no ceded lands inventory, there is a beginning at the UH Hawaiian Studies department but it is not yet complete, so this law would not be valid until such a study is completed.

I wish to also reference RTP funds with the state is supposed to use for recreational vehicle use, the state has not provided any new or more places. Kahuku, is one place and there are few other throughout the state. OHA has taken suit against the state, and maybe it will take another lawsuit, class action by recreational vehicle users to take back the money the state has ill-appropriated from the RTP fund. I ask that the committee please realize that our sports using off-road areas is not a crime and need not be if you would provide the proper places and/or facilities for them.

(a) No person shall operate a motor vehicle on land governed by this chapter except on roads, trails, or tracks designated or provided by the department for vehicular use. Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and shall be sentenced as follows:

DESIGNATED AREAS??!!!! THERE IS ONLY ONLY 2 LEGAL PLACES HERE ON OAHU - KAHUKU AND PEACOCK FLATS. HOW DO YOU EXPECT A COMMUNITY OF THOUSANDS TO JUST USE THESE AREAS?? HAWAII HAS SO MUCH TRAILS WHY ARE WE NOT ALLOWED TO USE THEM...ESPECIALLY PLACES THAT HAS BEEN USED FOR YEARS!

(2) For a second offense within five years of a previous conviction under this section, by a mandatory fine of not less that \$1,000 or imprisonment of not more than thirty days, or both; and

(3) For a third or subsequent offense within five years of a second conviction under this section, by a mandatory fine of not less than \$2,000 or imprisonment of not more than thirty days, or both.

(b) Any criminal action against a person for any violation under this section shall not be deemed to preclude the State from pursuing civil legal action to recover administrative fines and costs against the person. Any civil legal action against a person to recover administrative fines and costs for any violation of chapter 171 and rules adopted thereunder shall not be deemed to preclude the State from pursuing any criminal action against that person pursuant to this section.

(c) For purposes of this section, "motor vehicle" means every vehicle that is self-propelled, or propelled by electric power but not operated on rails, including but not limited to automobiles, trucks, go-carts, motorcycles, motor scooters, mopeds, all-terrain vehicles, and dune buggies

whether the vehicle is licensed or unlicensed."

Currently, *WAA*, along with private landowners and *DLNR*, tries to control these types of activities in and abutting *Kawainui Marsh*.

Although I recognize that off-roading can be fun and enjoyable, the activity needs to be conducted in appropriate areas, not isolated spots where endangered species – both plant and animal – grow and live.

We urge that you pass out SB 2926.

These are area the state ignored and the trash was thick to include vehicles, tires and a construction dumpster full of trash on the Habush cleanup. We contacted people in the media both times but it wasn't a good enough story for them.

There is land that is being transferred from the Navy that was part of Barbers Point Naval Air Station and some of this land would be a perfect area for a 4x4 vehicle park. One area is approx. 180 acres and cannot be built upon. Why is it that by DLNR's own annual report they admit they do not spend the proportional amount of federal RTP funds for four wheel trails? The state should look at putting its efforts into addressing the problem by providing a solution instead of trying to criminalize four wheeling, that has become part of Hawaii.
