## SUBJECT: S.B. 3034 - RELATING TO CIVIL DEFENSE

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of S.B. 3034 is to support the State Civil Defense

Shelter-In-Place initiative by exempting civil liability for care homes and schools, in

addition to hotels, during an officially designated emergency.

**DEPARTMENT'S POSITION:** As a partner in the State Civil Defense Shelter-In-

Place initiative, the Department of Human Services (DHS) strongly supports this

Administration bill to exempt civil liability for private owners or operators of care homes
