**Department's Position:** The Department strongly supports this Administration bill.

Purpose and Justification: This measure would allow the Department to establish and fill 3 epidemiologist positions, without regard to chapters 76 and 89, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The current 4 civil service epidemiological specialist position series is not sufficient for recruiting and retaining staff 5 6 with the technical expertise and multidisciplinary skills necessary to build and maintain the Department's capacity for public health surveillance and response. Epidemiologists function at a higher 7 level than epidemiological specialists, designing studies to address recurring public health problems 8 unique to our environment, collaborating with University colleagues to conduct applied research, 9 10 designing and evaluating health surveillance systems, and synthesizing the results of surveillance, investigations, and new scientific developments for use by public health decision-makers. 11 Our citizens need highly qualified, experienced epidemiologists to protect the State from new 12 and re-emerging diseases and to interrupt outbreaks rapidly, to minimize their impact on our people and 13 economic environment. 14
