A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CERTIFICATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 445-94, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 **"§445-94 Certificates.** [~~(a) No person shall operate a~~
4 ~~lodging or tenement house, group home, group residence, group~~
5 ~~living arrangement, hotel, or boardinghouse, until the person~~
6 ~~secures from the department of health a certificate setting~~
7 ~~forth that an agent of the department has examined the building~~
8 ~~or buildings, with a description sufficient to identify and~~
9 ~~locate the same, and that the same are in good sanitary~~
10 ~~condition.~~

11 ~~(b)]~~ No person shall operate a lodging or tenement house,
12 group home, group residence, group living arrangement, hotel, or
13 boardinghouse, until the person secures a clearance from the
14 appropriate county agency responsible for ensuring compliance
15 with county building and zoning codes setting forth that an
16 agent of the agency has examined the building or buildings,
17 proposed to be used for such purposes, with a description

1 sufficient to identify and locate the same; and that the same
2 are in compliance with the building and zoning codes."

3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4 and stricken.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
