- 5 upon checks issued by the comptroller; provided departments must
- 6 obtain the approval of the attorney general before payment of
- 7 any claim can be made.
- 8 SECTION 6. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as
- 9 interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest
- 10 shall be limited to the period from the date of judgment, if
- 11 applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this
- 12 part, as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for
- 13 those cases to which the statute applies.
- 14 SECTION 7. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
- 15 appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
- 16 June 30, 2010, shall lapse.
- 17 SECTION 8. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 18 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 19 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 20 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 21 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 22 of this Act are severable.

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1 SECTION 9. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
