## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
THIRTY-SECOND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much thereof  
3 as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof as may  
4 be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2009-2010 for the  
5 purpose of capital improvement projects for the benefit of the  
6 thirty-second representative district, as follows:

7 I. To be expended by the Department of Education:

8 A. Aiea Elementary School, Oahu

9 (1) Design and construction of a covered walkway  
10 connecting Building C with the cafeteria.

14 B. Aliamanu Middle School, Oahu

15 (1) Installation of 3 split-system air

14 SECTION 2. The sums appropriated for the respective  
 15 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the  
 16 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital  
 18 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
 19 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is  
 20 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation  
 21 unencumbered as of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.

22 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
