A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICAID.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Recently, the state department of human
2	services contracted for the administration of a new managed care
3	program, QUEST Expanded Access, for the aged, blind, and
4	disabled population. Of the awarded contracts, only two went to
5	for-profit insurance companies to provide medicaid coverage for
6	Hawaii's 37,000 aged, blind, and disabled residents. Several
7	states have found a number of serious law violations and
8	instances of Medicaid fraud in administering similar medicaid
9	programs through for-profit insurance companies. As a result,
10	legislation has surfaced throughout the United States that
11	permits only nonprofit and government-related entities to bid on
12	medicaid contracts.
13	The purpose of this Act is to require all future medicaid
14	procurement contracts to be awarded only to qualified nonprofit

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entities.

- 1 SECTION 2. Chapter 103F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§103F- Procurement of medicaid contracts; nonprofits.
- 5 The department of human services shall solicit proposals for the
- 6 procurement of all medicaid contracts in the State solely from
- 7 nonprofit insurance entities and award contracts solely to those
- 8 entities."
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 10 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 11 begun, before its effective date.
- 12 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
