
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTY-SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2009-2010 for the
5 purpose of capital improvement projects for the nineteenth
6 representative district, as follows:

11 SECTION 2. The sums appropriated for the respective
12 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
13 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
15 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
16 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
17 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
18 unencumbered as of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.

19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
