## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC WORKS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 104-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (h) to read as follows:  
3           "(h) When the department of budget and finance enters a  
4 project agreement with a project party, as those terms are  
5 defined in chapter 39A, to finance or refinance a project with  
6 the proceeds of special purpose revenue bonds, and such project  
7 party has entered into a collective bargaining agreement with a  
8 bona fide labor union governing the project party's workforce,  
9 and the collective bargaining agreement has been properly  
10 submitted to the director under section 104-34, the terms of  
11 that collective bargaining agreement and associated provisions  
12 shall be deemed the prevailing wages and terms serving as the  
13 basis of compliance with this [~~section~~] chapter for work on the  
14 project by the project party's workforce, provided, however,  
15 that this subsection does not affect the director's enforcement  
16 powers contained in subsection (g)."



# H.B. NO. 1676

1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
3 begun, before its effective date.

4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
