
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 287-20, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) Whenever a driver's license has been suspended or
4 revoked:

6 ~~291E, except as provided in section 291E-41(f),]~~

7 ~~[(2)]~~ (1) Upon a conviction of any offense pursuant to law;

11 the license shall not at any time thereafter be issued to the
12 person whose license has been suspended or revoked, nor shall
13 the person thereafter operate a motor vehicle, unless and until
14 the person has furnished and thereafter maintains proof of

15 financial responsibility; provided that this section shall not
16 apply to ~~[a license suspended pursuant to section 291E-61(b)(1)~~

17 ~~or (b)(2) or section 291E-64(b)(1),]~~ any conviction ~~[of]~~ for a

18 moving violation, any administrative license suspension pursuant



1 to chapter 291A, or the first conviction within a five-year
2 period for driving without a valid motor vehicle insurance
3 policy.


4 This subsection shall not apply to a suspension or
5 revocation of a license under chapter 291E or a provisional
