A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 343, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§343- Exception to applicability of chapter. (a)
5	Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, any primary
6	action that requires a permit or approval from an approving
7	agency that is not subject to the discretionary consent of the
8	approving agency and that involves a secondary action limited to
9	the installation, improvement, renovation, construction, or
10	development of infrastructure within an existing public right-
11	of-way or highway shall be exempt from this chapter; provided
12	that, if the infrastructure:
13	(1) Is not within an existing public right-of-way or
14	highway; or
15	(2) May have a significant effect on the environment,
16	then this section shall not apply.
17	(b) As used in this section:

1 "Infrastructure" includes but is not limited to waterlines 2 and water facilities, wastewater lines and wastewater 3 facilities, gas lines and gas facilities, drainage facilities, 4 electrical, communications, telephone, and cable television 5 utilities, and highway, roadway, and driveway improvements. 6 "Primary action" refers to any action outside of the 7 highway or public right-of-way that is on private property. 8 "Secondary action" refers to any infrastructure within the 9 highway or public right-of-way." **10** SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009, and

shall be repealed on July 1, 2011.
