## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ATTORNEYS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 28-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "§28-10 Prohibition on private practice of law by the  
4 attorney general, first deputy, and other deputies. The  
5 attorney general, the attorney general's first deputy, and other  
6 deputies shall devote their entire time and attention to the  
7 duties of their respective offices. They shall not engage in  
8 the private practice of law, nor accept any fees or emoluments  
9 other than their official salaries for any legal services. This  
10 section shall not apply to any special deputy attorney general  
11 employed by the attorney general on a part-time basis for a  
12 limited period."

13           SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

14           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
