## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
EIGHTEENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall  
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are  
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of  
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2009-2010:

5 1. To be expended by the department of education:

6 A. Kaiser and Kalani complex schools, Oahu

7 Design for performing arts auditorium.

8 Design \$250,000

9 Total Funding \$250,000

10 B. Aina Haina elementary school, Oahu

11 Design and construction for a public address system in  
12 the cafeteria.

13 Design \$5,000

14 Construction \$45,000

15 Total funding \$50,000



1 C. Kahala elementary school, Oahu  
2 Design and construction for re-roofing all the  
3 buildings, except the administration office, library,  
4 and cafeteria.

5	Design	\$40,000
6	Construction	\$360,000
7	Total funding	\$400,000

8 D. Kahala elementary school, Oahu  
9 Design and construction for repavement of the parking  
10 lot by the administration building and marking of  
11 parking stalls.

15 E. Kahala elementary school, Oahu  
16 Design and construction to renovate the school  
17 playground.
