
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A SUNRISE REVIEW OF GEOLOGIST LICENSURE.

1 WHEREAS, H.B. No. 2876, introduced during the Regular
2 Session of 2008, proposes to require licensure for persons who
3 hold themselves out to the public as geologists; and
4

5 WHEREAS, persons who presently hold themselves out as
6 geologists are not required to be licensed, certified,
7 registered, or otherwise regulated by the State; and
8

9 WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS),
10 requires that new regulatory measures being considered for
11 enactment that, if enacted, would subject unregulated
12 professions and vocations to licensing shall be referred to the
13 Auditor for analysis; and
14

15 WHEREAS, section 26H-6, HRS, further requires that referral
16 shall be by concurrent resolution that identifies a specific
17 bill to be analyzed; now, therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
20 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
21 of 2009, the Senate concurring, that in accordance with section
22 26H-6, HRS, the Auditor is requested to conduct a sunrise review
23 of the licensure of geologists as proposed in H.B. No. 2876,
24 2008; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is further
27 requested to submit findings and recommendations, including any
28 proposed legislation, to the Legislature not later than 20 days
29 prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2010; and
