
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE BOARD OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO REFRAIN
FROM SELLING OR EXCHANGING LANDS IN THE PUBLIC LAND TRUST.

1 WHEREAS, ceded lands are the former crown and government
2 lands of the Kingdom of Hawaii that were transferred to the
3 United States as part of Hawaii's annexation in 1898 and granted
4 to the State of Hawaii upon statehood in 1959; and
5

6 WHEREAS, section 5(f) of the Admission Act requires that
7 the State hold the ceded lands and proceeds and income therefrom
8 in a public trust for several purposes, including the betterment
9 of the conditions of native Hawaiians; and
10

11 WHEREAS, the 1993 Congressional Apology Resolution
12 recognized that the overthrow of the Kingdom of Hawaii was
13 illegal, the taking of the Kingdom's crown, government, and
14 public lands was without consent or compensation, and the
15 indigenous Hawaiian people never directly relinquished their
16 claims over their national lands to the United States; and
17

18 WHEREAS, in Act 359, Session Laws of Hawaii 1993, the
19 Legislature recognized that the overthrow was illegal, and found
20 that "[i]n 1898, Hawaii was annexed to the United States through
21 the Newlands Resolution without the consent of or compensation
22 to the indigenous people of Hawaii or their sovereign
23 government"; and
24

25 WHEREAS, native Hawaiians have unrelinquished claims to the
26 ceded lands; and
27

28 WHEREAS, until the claims of native Hawaiians are resolved,
29 the Board of Land and Natural Resources should not sell or
30 exchange the lands ceded to the United States by the Republic of
31 Hawaii under the joint resolution of annexation, approved on
32 July 7, 1898 (30 Stat. 750), or acquired in exchange for the
33 ceded lands and returned to the State of Hawaii by virtue of
34 section 5(b) of the Act of March 18, 1959 (73 Stat. 5), and
35 lands retained by the United States under section 5(c) and 5(d)



1 of the Act of March 18, 1959 (73 Stat. 5), and later conveyed to
2 the State under section 5(e) or under the Act of December 23,
3 1964 (77 Stat. 472); now, therefore,

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
6 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
7 of 2009, that the Board of Land and Natural Resources is
8 requested to refrain from selling or exchanging land in the
9 public land trust, crown lands, government lands, lands
10 identified in section 5 of the Admission Act, and lands held by
11 the Hawaiian Kingdom as of 1893, until the native Hawaiians'
12 unrelinquished claims to said lands are resolved; and

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
15 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of
16 Land and Natural Resources and the Chairperson of the Board of
17 Trustees of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs.
